The family is known for their Quaker philosophy and the chocolate conglomerate which they founded (now part of Cadbury Schweppes). He retired as Chairman of Cadbury Schweppes in 1989. He was Director of the Bank of England from 1970-1994 and of IBM from 1975-1994. Sir Adrian Cadbury was a pioneer in raising the awareness and stimulating the debate on corporate governance. He is most noted for the Cadbury Code, a code of Best Practice which served as a basis for reform of Corporate Governance around the world. He was member of the OECD Business Sector Advisory Group on Corporate Governance. His publications include: *Ethical Managers Make Their Own Rules*; *The Company Chairman*; *Corporate Governance and Chairmanship - A Personal View*. He was also Chancellor of Aston University until 2004.
