How to get there

Palampur is easily accessible by road, rail & air. It is 530 km north of Delhi on National High-way 20. You can drive via Chandigarh - Anandpur Sahib - Nangal - Una - Kangra. There are several overnight trains from Delhi to Pathankot from where Palampur is 3 hours drive. You can also fly from Delhi to Gaggal as and when flights are available. Gaggal is one hour drive from Palampur.
